



MRHC Junior Pathway Program Policies

General Policies

- Green Program and 8U Pathway Programs do not require an evaluation. Your child will be placed in a group based on age and skill level. You can sign-up by emailing juniorselectionprogram@gmail.com for Green and 8u Pathway programs at any time to secure a spot.
- Black and White Programs require an evaluation before entry, and we reserve the right to refuse entry based on our evaluation criteria.
- Member pricing is only available for people who are club members for the whole season.
- Your spot is not held for clinics until you have signed up and paid.
- Once payment is made, you are locked into the slots, and refunds/credits will not be given for changes in your plans (see makeup policies below).
- All payments for all indoor programs must be made by calling or physically paying at MRHC's front desk. If you are a club member, please let us know your member #, and we will charge your club account.
- Please do not talk to or signal to your child about anything related to their tennis class during class. This distraction does not help your child and only takes away from the instruction the coach is trying to give them.
- These policies are for the Green, White, Black, and 8u Pathway Programs run by coaches Sean, Mohamed, Ricky, and Conor. These policies do not extend to programs taught by other coaches within MRHC.
- Pictures and/or video may be taken by our staff during classes and can be used for future promotional material and online presence.

MAKEUPS

- Your child will be eligible for the following number of makeups depending on which program they are in.
 - Black Program – Two makeups TOTAL
 - All other Programs – One makeup per class
- To be eligible for a makeup, you must provide 48-hour notice by emailing juniorselectionprogram@gmail.com that the class will be missed.
- The following situations are the only situations in which your child will be eligible for more than two makeups or to be given makeup with less than a 48-hour notice (max of 10 makeups under any circumstances).
 - a. Injury – Doctors Note Required
 - b. Sickness – Doctors Note Required
 - c. Death In the Family – Proof Required
- Anything weather-related for outdoor clinics (Does not include it being too hot)
- Makeups must be scheduled by emailing David Wheeler within seven days of the missed class. This is so that everyone isn't trying to schedule makeups at the end of the season.
- If a makeup is scheduled, it can not be canceled. If it is canceled or missed, it will count as makeup. So, only schedule a makeup if you know you can make it.
- We reserve the right to exceed our student to court or student to coach ratio up to two times per class, per season, to get everyone in for makeups.
- Please try your best to do outdoor makeups where possible, as this will allow us to keep the student: court ratio low.
